ORDER

1. Theresa Harvey Pruden is appointed to undertake a comprehensive review of *The Accessibility for Manitobans Act*.
2. The Minister of Families is authorized to enter into an agreement with Theresa Harvey Pruden respecting the terms and conditions of her appointment.
3. This Order comes into effect on the day it is made.

AUTHORITY

The Accessibility for Manitobans Act, C.C.S.M. c. A1.7, states:

Review of this Act

39(1) Within four years after this Act comes into force, the minister must appoint a person who is to undertake a comprehensive review of the effectiveness of this Act and report on his or her findings to the minister.

LG in C approval required

39(2) The person to be appointed by the minister must be approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council before the appointment becomes effective.

The Executive Government Organization Act, C.C.S.M. c. E170

Agreements with other authorities

16 The Lieutenant Governor in Council may authorize a minister, for and on behalf of the government, or an agency of the government, to enter into an agreement with

- (a) the Government of Canada, or a minister or agency of the Government of Canada; or
- (b) the government of another province of Canada, or a minister or agency of the government of another province of Canada; or

(c) a municipality, school district, school division, or other local authority;
or

(d) any person or group of persons;

for the benefit or purposes of the residents of Manitoba or any part thereof.

BACKGROUND

1. The Accessibility for Manitobans Act came into force on December 5, 2013.
