



# MANITOBA ORDER IN COUNCIL

DATE: **April 17, 2019**

ORDER IN COUNCIL NO.: **131/2019**

RECOMMENDED BY: **Minister of Municipal Relations**

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## ORDER

1. Diane Stasiuk is appointed as a member of the Municipal Board, to serve in the position of Vice Chair of the Municipal Board, within the classification of Senior Officer 5 (SF5), within the salary range of \$109,620 to \$131,238 per year and where applicable a long service step to \$133,829. The starting salary is \$126,510 per year (\$4,849.53 bi-weekly) effective May 1, 2019.
2. Order in Council 334/2013 is rescinded effective January 10, 2019.

## AUTHORITY

*The Municipal Board Act*, C.C.S.M. c. M240 states:

### **Appointment to board**

**7** The members shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and shall be paid such remuneration as is determined by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

### **Appointment of staff**

**8** The secretary of the board and such other permanent officers and employees as may be necessary for carrying on the business of the board, shall be appointed as provided in *The Civil Service Act*.

*The Civil Service Act*, C.C.S.M. c. C110, states:

### **Appointments by commission**

**15** Subject as herein otherwise provided, appointments, transfers, and promotions to positions, and reclassifications to positions having a lower maximum salary, shall be made by the commission subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

### **Date and condition of appointment**

**17(1)** The commission shall determine the date upon which, and the conditions under which, an appointment, transfer, or promotion is effective and the conditions under which it terminates.

### **Retroactive appointments**

**17(2)** The commission may make an appointment, transfer, or promotion of an employee to a position effective retroactively to a date prior to the date on which it is made if the employee had actually assumed the duties of the position on or before the date that the appointment, transfer or promotion is effective.

## BACKGROUND

1. The previous incumbent retired on January 10, 2019.
2. The Commission has held a competition in accordance with *The Civil Service Act*.
