ORDER

1. Paragraph 2 of Order in Council 389/2018 which appointed David Cheop as a member and designated him as Chair of the Manitoba Securities Commission for a three-year renewable term is amended to correct David Cheop's starting salary by deleting the amount "\$152,477" and substituting "\$164,203".

AUTHORITY

The Securities Act, C.C.S.M. c. S50, states:

Commission continued

2(1) The Manitoba Securities Commission composed of not more than seven members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council is continued.

Chair and vice-chair

2(2) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall designate one of the members of the commission as chair and another as vice-chair.

Chief executive officer

3(1) The chair shall be the chief executive officer of the commission and shall devote his or her full time to the work of the commission.

The Civil Service Act, C.C.S.M. c. C110, states:

Appointment of deputy ministers, etc., and other technical officers

32 Unless they are appointed by Act of the Legislature, the Lieutenant Governor in Council shall appoint

...

- (b) the members, or members of the board of management or boards of directors, of agencies of the government with respect to which any provision of this Act has been brought into force.
