



MANITOBA ORDER IN COUNCIL

ORDER IN COUNCIL NO.: **157/2019**

RECOMMENDED BY: **Minister of Finance**

ORDER

1. Treasury Board is assigned to carry out a review of policies and processes for land use and development under the authority of Manitoba statutes and municipal by-laws, including zoning decisions and the issuance and administration of permits.
2. This order comes into effect on the day that it is made and expires on May 8, 2020.

AUTHORITY

The Financial Administration Act, C.C.S.M. c. F55, states:

Authority of Treasury Board

5 In addition to matters specifically assigned to it under this or any other Act of the Legislature, Treasury Board is responsible for

- (a) preparing the estimates;
- (b) government-wide management practices and systems;
- (c) government fiscal management and control, including the management and control of expenditures and revenues;
- (d) evaluating government programs;
- (e) approving the organization of government departments and the staffing complement and spending levels required for the delivery of government programs;
- (f) ensuring accountability of government departments to the Legislature for the delivery of government programs; and
- (g) other matters assigned to it by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

BACKGROUND

1. Policies and processes applied to land use and development may influence investment decisions and the Manitoba economy.
2. The review will be carried out by Treasury Board Secretariat staff, who will request input from the authorities that are responsible for land use and development under Manitoba statutes and municipal by-laws and from stakeholders.
3. The review will include a literature review, a cross-jurisdictional scan and analysis of the policies and processes of authorities that are responsible for land use and development under Manitoba statutes and municipal by-laws.
