ORDER

The regulation set out in the attached Schedule A, which amends the *Pharmaceutical Regulation*, is approved.

AUTHORITY

The Pharmaceutical Act, C.C.S.M. c. P60, states:

Regulations

73(1) The council may make regulations

..

(k) respecting the prescribing and administering of drugs by a member, either independently or collaboratively with other practitioners, including

...

(ii) designating drugs that a member may prescribe or administer,

...

(t) specifying the manner in which records must be made and maintained, including requiring the use of computer systems for record-keeping;

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Regulation may apply to part of the province, classes of persons

73(4) A regulation may be general or particular in its application and may apply to one or more classes of persons, and to the whole or any part of the province.

Consultation

- **74(1)** Before making a regulation under subsection 73(1), the council must
 - (a) provide a copy of the proposed regulation, for review and comment, to
 - (i) the members of the college,
 - (ii) the minister, and
 - (iii) any other person the council considers necessary; and
 - (b) consider the comments received.

Approval of regulations

74(2) A regulation under subsection 73(1) does not come into force until it is approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

BACKGROUND

The College of Pharmacists of Manitoba made the regulation set out in the attached Schedule A. The council of the college provided a copy of the proposed regulation for review and comment, and the council considered the comments received.
