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### ORDER

The regulation set out in the attached Schedule A, which amends the *Pharmaceutical Regulation*, is approved.

### AUTHORITY

*The Pharmaceutical Act*, C.C.S.M. c. P60, states:

#### Regulations

**73(1)** The council may make regulations

...

(k) respecting the prescribing and administering of drugs by a member, either independently or collaboratively with other practitioners, including

...

(ii) designating drugs that a member may prescribe or administer,

...

(t) specifying the manner in which records must be made and maintained, including requiring the use of computer systems for record-keeping;

...

#### Regulation may apply to part of the province, classes of persons

**73(4)** A regulation may be general or particular in its application and may apply to one or more classes of persons, and to the whole or any part of the province.

#### Consultation

**74(1)** Before making a regulation under subsection 73(1), the council must

(a) provide a copy of the proposed regulation, for review and comment, to

(i) the members of the college,

(ii) the minister, and

(iii) any other person the council considers necessary; and

(b) consider the comments received.

#### Approval of regulations

**74(2)** A regulation under subsection 73(1) does not come into force until it is approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

## **BACKGROUND**
