ORDER

1. Lauralee Gooding of Winnipeg is appointed as a lay member of the Board of The Manitoba Chiropractors Association (the "Board") for a term of two (2) years commencing March 11, 2026.
2. This Order comes into effect on March 11, 2026.

AUTHORITY

The Chiropractic Act, C.C.S.M. c. C100, states:

Composition of the Board

22(1) The board of the association shall be composed of

- (a) five persons elected from among the members of the association in accordance with the by-laws of the association governing elections; and
- (b) two lay persons, one of whom shall be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, and one of whom shall be appointed by the elected members of the board.

Term of lay board members

23(2) The term of office of each board member who is a lay person shall be two years but the member may be re-appointed upon the expiration of their term.
