### ORDER

1. Randi Salamanowicz (the “Administrator”) is appointed as administrator for the Town of Winnipeg Beach.
2. The appointment of Randi Salamanowicz as administrator for the Town of Winnipeg Beach is revoked at 12 noon on July 25, 2026.
3. This order takes effect on the day it is made.

### AUTHORITY

*The Municipal Act, C.C.S.M. c. M225, states:*

**Term of office after general election**

**99(1)** The term of office of a member of a council elected at a general election starts at 12 noon on the day following the election and ends at 12 noon on the day following the next general election.

...

**Appointment of administrator if no council or quorum**

**103** Despite section 102, if the number of members of a council is fewer than is required for a quorum or if a council resigns, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint an administrator for the municipality, in which case the provisions of Division 6 (Municipalities in Financial Difficulties) of Part 6 relating to administrators apply with necessary modifications.

...

**Minimum number for quorum**

**135(3)** Subject to The Municipal Council Conflict of Interest Act, the minimum number for a quorum of a council is three.

...

**Restoration of municipal status**

**217** Where the Lieutenant Governor in Council considers it advisable to provide that the affairs of the municipality again be conducted by a council, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may by order

(a) make suitable provisions for the election of a new council for the municipality;

(b) revoke the appointment of the administrator effective upon such election; and

(c) authorize the minister to require the municipality and its chief administrative officer to submit annually to the minister particulars of its program as set out in clauses 200(2)(a) to (c).

## **BACKGROUND**

1. As of April 30, 2026, the council of the Town of Winnipeg Beach does not have the minimum number of members of council for a quorum.
2. An administrator is needed to administer the affairs of the Town of Winnipeg Beach until a new council is elected.
3. The Administrator will have the powers and authority of the council until a new council is elected.
4. It is advisable to provide that the affairs of the municipality again be conducted by a council, once elected in the 2026 general election, which is currently underway.
